

# WELCOME to End Of The Trail Campground



We are a campground with **as few rules as possible**; but the ones we do have we sincerely hope you will abide by to keep life here easy-going.

## CHECK IN:

- Stop in at the office BEFORE setting up your site

## BOOKING:

- **Two night** booking required for **Friday and Saturdays**
- **Three night** booking for **holidays**
- All dates sites, stalls, and electric that were booked, *REGARDLESS* whether you *come late or leave early* will be charged to you in full if you do show

## MULTIPLE SITE BOOKING:

- Requires a non-refundable deposit of 50% on EACH SITE/EACH RIG in a site (credit can be given toward a future booking)

## CANCELLATIONS:

- If you do not call or do not show up, all **FUTURE** bookings require **FULL payment in advance**

## SITES:

- Paid for **BY THE RIG**, not by they site as our sites are roomy and can hold multiple rigs
- **Tents:** First tent is free, each one after that = \$5/night

## STALLS:

- Charge for box stalls is **PER horse** as many like to put 2 horses in our big stalls.
- Clean all manure and hay out of your stall prior to leaving **OR** we can do so for a \$5/charge (*please ask ahead on this service*)
- **Portable fencing IS allowed**, BUT in areas that we designate ☺
- **NO tying horses to the trailer overnight** as it really makes a muddy mess of the site. Thanks for the help in keeping the campground looking nice for others.

## FIRES:

- Firewood is available for a donation of your choice!
- Please **DO NOT** move the fire pits, it keeps our sites much nicer for all to enjoy

## GARBAGE:

- Please deposit in the dumpster by the office

## MANURE:

- **Please** do NOT throw it over the fence, that area is NOT our land. Use the manure spreaders provided

## DOGS:

- Are welcome, BUT, for LIABILITY reasons & respect for others they need to be on a leash when walking around camp.
- Dogs in Wildcat must be leashed
- Dogs in Kickapoo can run AFTER nesting season ends (July 31<sup>st</sup>)



**WE ENFORCE THE DOG RULES, AS DO the park rangers!!**

## BATHING HORSES:

- You are welcome to do so, just move them around a bit so it does not make so much mud

## ELECTRIC HOOKUPS:

- Rigs with air, heat, hot water heaters, etc should plug into the 30 AMP plugs. Make sure your cords are heavy enough. Ask for help if you have questions.
- Our electric boxes are state approved and inspected and will SHUT OFF if your cord becomes overloaded; we have 30 amp cords at the office if you need them

## TRAIL PASSES:

- REQUIRED for EACH trail system (you WILL get fined without one)
  - \$4/daily each horse OR
  - \$15 annual each horse (for riders 16 and over)

**Keep in mind, it is very costly to keep and maintain these trails, so lets purchase the necessary passes to ensure our trails stay open!!**

## QUIET TIME:

- We do not currently have a quiet time, just please use your common sense, tone it down by 11 pm, unless your neighbors are partying too 😊

## SHOWERS:

- Located in the big dairy barn (in the old milk house)


## TREATS:

- Ice and ice cream bars are located in the barn freezer (where the horse stalls are)...put your money in the can, it is on the "honor system"


## ALSO AVAILABLE:

- Camp hats, T-shirts and sweatshirts in the office, along with a few tack items and "guardian leather crosses" to hang in your truck, on your horse or wherever you see fit!

**Happy Trails...Some thoughts for you to keep in mind**

-  ONE uncaring rider could ruin it for all of us (and have done so as some areas are now closed off)

 Pack it in and Pack it OUT
